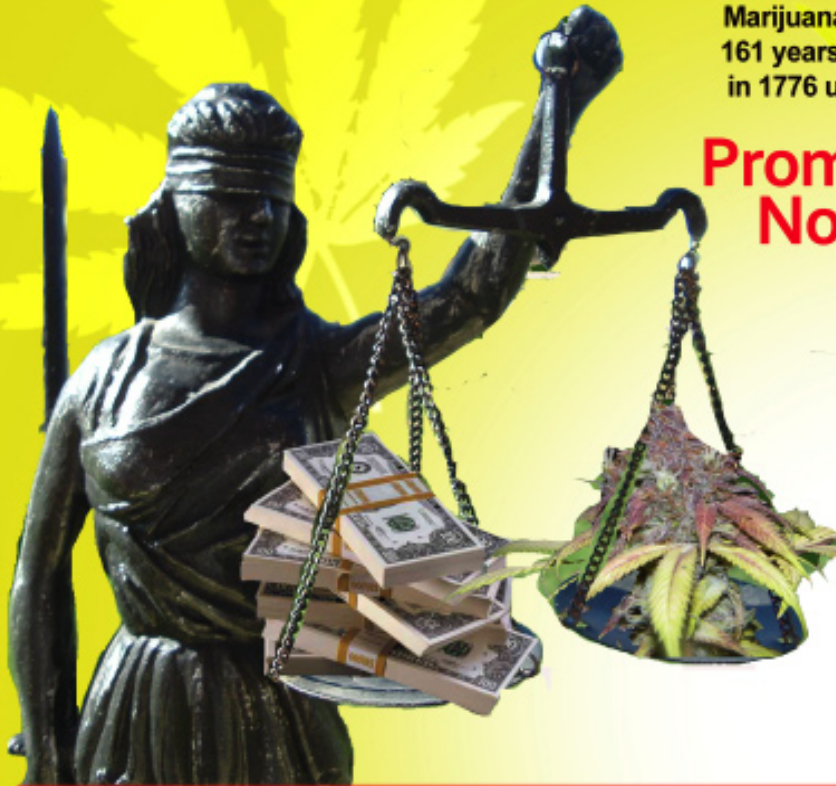


Should Marijuana be Legalized?
